It is no easy task to assist someone out of the water between the boat and finger. **If they had not been there to help me, I don't know what could have happened** -- would I have been able to get out by myself or swim to shore and climb out on the rocks especially considering the fact that I am not a strong swimmer and did not have a life jacket on.

I'm one of the lucky ones, nothing hurt but my pride, a few bumps and bruises and a raging headache for about a week, and a few jabs from well meaning people trying to make light of what should have been a funny incident. **I really want you to think and see yourself in this situation. For those of you who say this could never happen to me, you are wrong because it could.**

I love our Club and our friends and feel honored to be a part of such a great group of people.

In closing, my only wish for those of you reading this, is that you remain as careful as you are and never lose that knowledge that our water is more powerful than we are so don't take it for granted.

What is the Cruising Class

It's a fun way to do the Delta and if you make arrangement with the Stockton Sailing Club (209-951-5600) you can stay awhile.
