JUNE BOARD MEETING NOTES

Dredging Committee –Chris Shepherd

Kjeldsen, Sinnock and Neudeck have completed the hydrographic survey of the harbor.

- ? We were provided with a set of drawings that presented the data from the harbor survey from 2000 and the survey done last month.
- ? Comparison of the two surveys showed that the harbor has silted in a total of 5 inches in the last 4 years. (1.25 inches per year) Some areas show more deposits than others.

2004 Youth LTS Program – started on June 7th and is doing very well.

General Meeting Suggestions

Budge Humphreys was able to find an answering machine system that has four (4) mail boxes. He is proceeding with this project and will find volunteers to handle and update the mailboxes from time to time.

Nominating Committee

Ed Almaas, Bobby Doscher and Al Farnum have volunteered to assemble members for the Nominating Committee.

Awards Banquet & Installation Dinner

The Board requested the Harbormaster check the availability of the Stockton Golf & County Club for the 2005 Awards Banquet and Installation Dinner. Target dates: Jan. 15 or Jan. 22, 2005.

Sandbox Sand Replacement

Concern was expressed about the need to keep the sandbox as a play area. This was referred to the Harbor & Facilities Committee.

Flag halyard clips/maintenance

Edgar Okafuji will replace the clips.

FBLI – Al Farnum

FBLI analyzed the projected figures for the last four months (Dec. – March 2004) that were used to make up the budget for FYE 3-31-05. A spreadsheet was prepared that showed a projected full year (FYE 3-31-04) that was used for budget purposes vs. the actual full year presented by the Harbormaster and what FBLI had projected for FYE 3-31-05 for comparison purposes. It was determined by the

committee that there were some differences in our assumptions but they did not materially affect the budget that had been presented and passed by the membership. The budget as originally presented stands.

Harbor and Facilities – Doug Haas

Edgar Okafuji has obtained two (2) bids for the replacement of the harbor office roof. The bids will be ready for review next month.

- ✍ Edgar will look at the headwalk on I Dock and determine the cause so we can determine responsibility and if it is a minor repair to fix it.
- ✍ Estimates for installing a dumbwaiter ranged from \$14,000 to \$15,000. This would not include the construction of the shaft box and electrical hookup. The committee will look at the cost of an outside lift similar to our handicap lift which could be used for freight as well as serve as an emergency backup for our existing handicap lift.

If no money is due the Club on the 28th day of the month, members are entitled to a 30% credit on their berth rent and the dues for the following month. This discount does not apply to cruising/non-resident membership categories.

Harbor Rule addition to address the launching and storage of personal watercraft.

Recommended text:

No personal watercraft may be launched or stored in the harbor or on club premises.

Personal watercraft will be treated as any other visiting vessel with regards to mooring or operation within the harbor.
