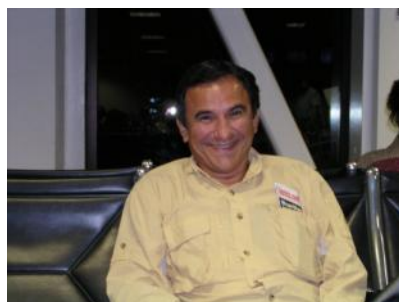

**Commodore Comments**

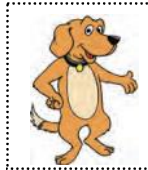

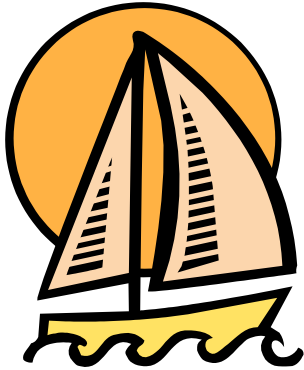
### Make your Move....to the Front!
