Candidate Statements for SSC Director

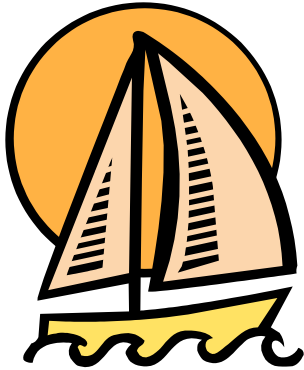

Revise ARTICLE VIII Members; (1) Membership categories; (H) as follows:

(H)Youth and Learn-To-Sail Memberships shall be designated for any person who is not a Family or Young Adult Member or dependent of a Family Members and is participation in Club sponsored youth or Learn-To-Sail program approved by the Board of Directors for use of specified Club facilities. The age range of this membership is defined by each program. The membership terminates at the close of each program. Collective dues paid during one calendar year, while holding this membership category, are applicable to a Family, Young Adult or Junior Membership application within thirty days of the last program attended. Rights and privileges are limited to use of the facilities, with access to the Clubhouse only for adults or youths with adult supervision.

After leaving Morro Bay our next stop will be the anchorage at **PORT SAN LUIS**. (25 miles south). You can pick up a mooring ball located next to the commercial fuel dock. We like to anchor off Avila beach which is between 2nd & 3rd piers in the bay. Like most of the anchorages along this part of the coast this anchorage is open to south & west weather. In a pinch you could move up near the breakwater next to the fuel dock. There are no slips here. There are a few stores ashore at Avila Beach and a restaurant on the commercial pier. Dolphins and seals chase the fish through the anchorage. The Sunsets/ rises are beautiful! This is a good place to wait for fair weather to get around point conception! One of my favorite anchorages along this coast.

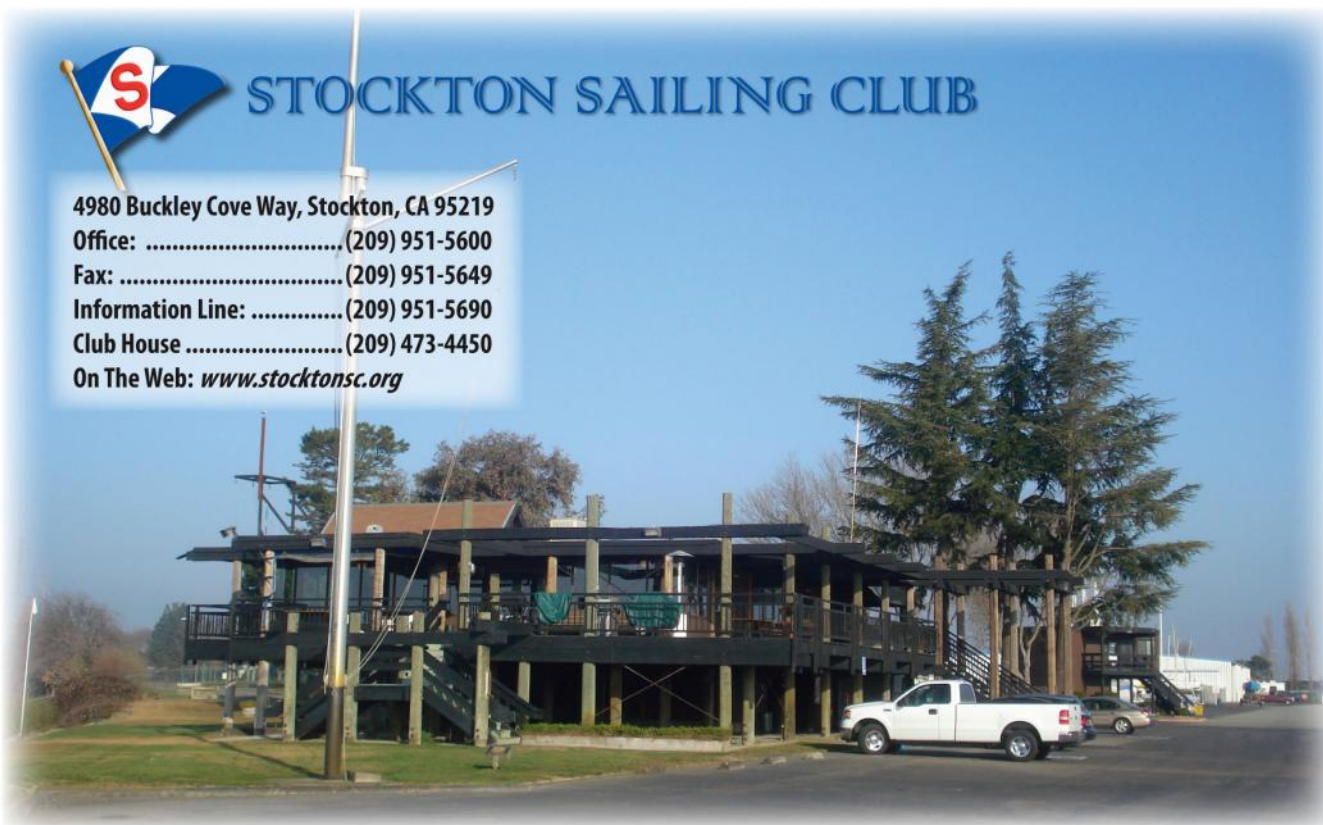
