## Cruising to Southern California

Our next stop is COJO ANCHORAGE. 45 miles south of Port San Luis and around Points ARGUELLO & CONCEPTION. This trip should be done in light NW winds or fog and no wind at all. Many take the trip at night and this means just motoring through before the winds build. Believe me it's not a very pleasant place when the wind is up! When traveling south, make an early start to avoid rounding Point Conception late in the day. Once you round Pt. conception, Cojo is only about 6 miles east. It can be

tricky getting into the anchorage. You will need to avoid the huge black mooring ball that is for the ships servicing the oil rigs offshore. Once past the mooring ball pull up towards the beach. Make sure to avoid the kelp beds in the shallow waters off the beach. Cojo has been used by Mariners for decades. It's remoteness is sometimes peaceful but, quite often blustery with winds of 35+.

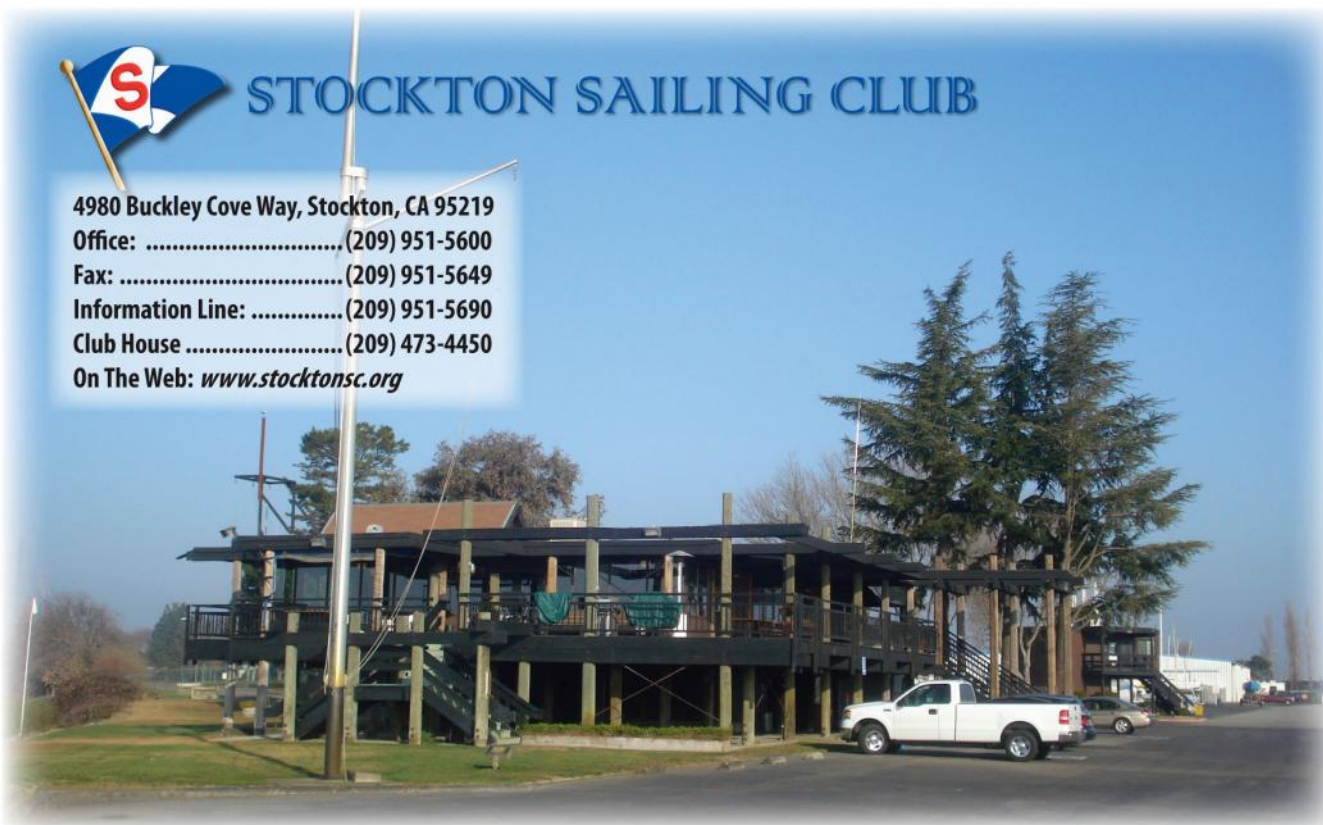
