1. Installation Dinner: \$2,200 over budget total cost. Loss due to poor attendance. Total cost of installation dinner \$3,284.
2. Coffee: The clubhouse coffee cost YTD is: \$1,300. Discussed costs and amount of coffee beans vs. the old club standard coffee Folgers at lower cost to be used again.
3. Office is working on club member roster. Still in progress for completion.
4. Stockton fire department was here for inspections on club property for the removal of stand pipes. Currently we have two fire hydrants on club property for use of city water

III. **Old Business:**

a. **Dredging:**

Burt Mohr had a meeting with the land owners and the contractors with the District 684 that covers Windmill Cove and Roberts Island areas. The District sent back request for the following: 1. Permits 2. Description of the dredge material disposal and timeline 3. Plans for the water disposal drainage 4. Request of engineering drawings 5. End of week return survey 6. Evidence of consent from land owner.

b. **Retreat Rental Agreement:**

New Forms are in process with new alterations of the Retreat Rental Agreement with Rules and Policy committee.

IV. New Business

a. **FYE 03/31/13 Budget:**

- FBFI group met last Saturday and worked on the presentation of the budget for board approval. SSC Proposed Budget 3/31/13 submitted to board for discussion.
- Peter Hine discussed the Month to Month tenancy with Dwayne's business, dock and rental of the building on our property. Discussed dock rental and occupancy of boat rental space. If he vacates and terminates his lease the amount is paid currently is \$3200 per month plus reimbursements of utilities. Harbor & Facilities has concerns regarding Dwayne's boats staggering beyond one week on A dock. Issues discussed placements of his inventory and solutions regarding the size of boats not fitting in his assigned dock area.
- Other items, salary & wages: no wage increases recommended by FBFI group which is requested for 3% raise denied.
- There is noted increase in repairs for harbor and facilities YTD \$50, 500. Past cost \$25k-\$35k YTD deferred maintenance held back from last year.
- Discretionary spending limit questioned for office manager Suzi Wasielewski Harbor Master signing authority for items purchased for business, maintenance and functions.

Board agreed to NOT set limitation at her discretion and trust her signing authority.

b. **Taste of the Delta Event / Social & Cruise Committee**

Motion was made to consider the Delta Chamber of Commerce hold their annual Taste of the Delta event at SSC as their premier destination on the Delta. Motion was made / defeated by 5/4. Board suggest they like the idea but cannot approve at this time due to requesting further information at the March meeting with special guest Trisha Meager of Delta Chamber of Commerce and Stockton Chamber of Commerce to speak. P/H A/A MSP

c. **Harbor & Facilities, Harbor Facility issues, maintenance questions, budget questions**

January Meeting updates: see below

1. **Stockton fire department** concluded their inspections and the removal of the stand pipes which are very old.
2. **Harbor & Facilities** current projects in review of paint of upstairs deck.
3. Sprinkler Project: map presented to board showing all zones and areas where well and city water is utilized.
4. **Roof**, requested information on past years work and monies spent and current allotment for complete roof replacement. 2011 Board of Directors approved \$25k 2011, for patch work.
5. **Fire Extinguishers**; 27 dock extinguishers have been temporarily removed for paint and repair. Edgar Bassano, club member has business and is in process of sanding and painting the color white with red letters. This service was provided free of charge of Mr. Bassano.
6. **Outboard motors**: request of old motors to be sold. Post notice to sale at clubhouse. One motor Mr. Walt Anders or any other person's interest to request to pay \$100.00 is approved by board. **APPROVED BH/AA M/S/P.**
7. **New Shop Policy** submitted for approval from Harbor and Facilities committee. Board noted withdraw of shop rules material handouts and request to move concerns to Rules & Policy committee for review and future follow up with the board. Motion for approve to withdraw **Approved JC/SL/PH M/S/A**
8. **Honorary young adult membership** for Brenton Vanderpol awarded for fees waived until the age of 30 years old due to illness and active participation. Vote in favor agreed by board to waive fee.
APPROVED. Unanimously by all board members. PH/DD/ BH M/S/P
9. **Keys**: Discussed concerns of club members / past board members with key access to offices, storage facilities, security office and closets. Item of concerns are loss, privacy issues such as financial information of club members, credit card numbers, reports, Motion to reset and rekey most sensitive areas: bar pantry, office, security, two storage rooms (bat cave/ furnace room)with magnetic card keys. **AA/ BH APPROVED M/S/P**
10. **Front Gate**: Board has policy for gate to be closed at all times other than special events approved from committee chairmen, board liaisons requested to the office. Brought forth are concerns of unwanted persons (non- invited guests) walking/biking/driving/ loitering on premises. Request for more security and to request tenant West Cal has its customers use provided entrance for their business and not the main gate during the day. Further research of gate and policies to be researched for further discussion at next month's meeting.

Bashing Home from Mexico PART 3

After returning to Cabo with a sick crew member we finally restarted our journey home. Sailing when we could, motor sailing when we couldn't, before we knew it we were in Turtle Bay. Not able to get fuel until the next morning we ate and showered ashore and headed out before noon. The next thing we knew we were tied up at the police/customs dock in San Diego, seven days after we left Cabo. I'm sure by many sailing standards that is slow, but making 750 miles "uphill" against wind and current it is half the time we expected. Hearing that a storm was headed for Northern California in three days, we figured if we could make it to somewhere like Monterey we would be home free. We made a rhomb line for 20 miles west of Point Conception, going outside all but one of the Channel Islands. Late at night as we approached the famous (infamous?) point with one of our crew under the weather, our fuel lower than it should have been, 10-foot seas, and winds on the nose gusting in the 30s, we decided Santa Barbara would make a nice stop. After a short rest at Cojo anchorage, we headed to what would be our boat's home for two weeks while we drove home for the Thanksgiving holiday in a rental car. Two weeks later with the original crew of three, and sailing buddy Steve, our weather knowledge way up the learning curve, and a three-day window, we headed to Santa Barbara in a rental car. We left Santa Barbara at approximately 2030 and went under the Golden Gate, 380 sea miles, approximately 47 hours after we left. Entering the Bay with a 2.9 knot flood, we headed for our home and slip in Discovery Bay. Being approximately one whole day ahead of schedule, we checked the tide table and everything was aligned, we should be going through the skinny water at high tide. As night became morning, and 10 miles from home, we were so socked in with tulle fog, we dropped the hook in False River at 0330. At first light we were woken up by duck hunters doing their thing in Frank's Tract, and headed for home.
