### September 11, 2012

**Call to Order:** Commodore John Moyer called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM.

#### **Standing Business:**

A: **Agenda:** Motion to Approve September Agenda. Approved: AA/PH M/S/P.

B: **Minutes:** Motion to Approve August Minutes AA/PH MSP Approved. Motion to Approve July Corrected Minutes PH/BM MSP Approved PH abstained.

#### **C: Club Manager Report:**

- The new computers are installed and running in the sales office. Board of Directors voted to dispose all old computers to E-Waste for complete destruction. PH/BM MSP Approved
- SSC stolen boat has been recovered. There was a cost of \$380.00
- Parking lot boat storage is full. Waiting list now pending.
- Office management has asked to Board of Directors to consider hiring non-member Karen Miller fulltime for Learn to Sail
- Hot August nights has been reported as successful
- Office Manager notified the Board of Directors that she is taking two weeks vacation time
- ALX security systems to bid on security camera installation. Referred to Harbor & Facilities to further research.
- Guest from Richmond Yacht Club—Sam Crabtree and Suzie Wilson mailed letter thanking SSC for such wonderful hospitality.

#### **D: Correspondence:**

#### **E: Member Comments:**

- **Utilities:** Club member, Marvin McDougal presented a bid by Energy Retrofit Company. The bid reflects the scope of work to remove old shoebox, flood and halogen flood lights and replace with energy efficient lighting Induction Retro kits. Total cost of the project is \$11,061.00, which also includes a CA State refunded rebate of \$1,020.00. Total amount of in-

stallation and project payable by SSC is \$10,041.00 after rebate. The Second payment option, PG&E is offering 0% on Bill Financing Program 60 months payment \$167.35. Total monthly energy savings with the retrofit \$198.01. Existing system annual Kwh used 18,159, new system total Kwh 8,118 at the energy rate of \$0.15 Annual Energy Savings \$1,505.15. PH requested project be tracked. PH/AA MSP Approved

- **Security:** Club Member, Chris Sheppard spoke about the spike in crime and stolen property recently at our club. Reported was a member's automobile, club boat, miscellaneous boat parts stolen—motors, covers, wrenches, etc. It was suggested by Chris we close the gate 24 hours a day for maximum security to rid of intruders. Chris witnessed 3 different scavengers at different times in the office parking lot inside the dumpsters digging through our garbage.

#### **Old Business:**

- A: Utilities/Marvin McDougal. See notes under Member and Guest Comments.
- B: Nominations presented and approved by Secretary, Deborah Doscher at 7:00pm. Questions surfaced regarding the nominees, voting and nomination process for club members at the general meetings. Phil Hendrix requested the By Law committee to research the verbiage in the current by laws to allow members to nominate others or themselves at the General Friday Night meeting to run for elected office. BM/AA MSP Approved.

#### **New Business:**

- **Security:** Harbor and Facilities requested to close the main entrance gate 24 hours a day to research the gate activity and study the hours needed for surveillance cameras. During events held at the retreat, it's the duty of the Club Manager to enforce the rental party to hire security. If it's a club event, our Club Manager will make arrangements to have the gate open for a short period of time managed with a guard to assist with guests and club members. Board of Directors gives the club manager access to security gate assistant. BM/AA MSP Approved
- **Membership Safety:** Harbor and Facilities reported an accident with a member who was in their car which went into the water near H Dock. IT was said the member involved was not harmed and was fortunate to have been rescued by club member Lila Primm. It's unknown if the accident was reported to Stockton Police Department for further investigation.

#### **Committee Reports:**

- A: Dredging Committee: A bid was submitted by SSC to the

farmer for the dredging to build the levees. Burt Mohr reported that we should have the final permits approved by Friday 9/14.

- B: Membership Committee: 3 new applications submitted. Mike & Karen Little, David East, David & Julie Wilson. PH FR MSP Approved.
- C: Harbor & Facilities Committee:
  - Submitted a report of the Major Capital Outlay Projects after Dredging. The outline details the plans replace/repairs on all the docks, parking lot, office, repair clubhouse superstructure, repair point peninsula and complete bar remodel. Estimated cost \$2.0 mm
  - Final October, November, December projects were reviewed. Phil Hendrix stated the 5 year plan for 20132018 is scheduled for completion by 10/09/12 by Chairman Linda Driver.
- D: FBLI Committee: No report
- E: Regatta Committee: No report
- F: Rules and Policies Committee: No Report
- G: Social and Cruise Committee: Halloween Party, Saturday October 27th is in process and is in need of volunteers.
- H: Junior Sail Committee: Request to use club trailer. Club Manager reported there is a wailer trailer available in the small boat yard for them to use.

**Dredging Time is Currently Underway...**

Preparations for dredging are underway. One of the most important Chores that will have to be done to get ready for the project will be the moving of boats out of their slips. The club would greatly prefer that you move your own boat. The best move would be to find another marina or location where you can moor your boat for at least two weeks (Chris Sheppard has been contacting marinas and most them are able to put you up for that period of time). For those of you who have a trailer for your boat, the club will find room for your trailer during the dredging process. If the club has to move your boat, we will disconnect your shore power cord and will not plug your boat back into shore power when it is returned to your slip. Please be sure to provide at least four fenders and dock lines (the dock lines will go with the boat). There may be some other "conditions"—we'll let you know!

Boats on the end ties will be the first that need to be moved and will be displaced for the longest period of time.

Next will be the brokerage boats at Wes Cal Yacht Sales (Duane is already prepared to move those boats out) and those on the north side of H dock.

Next will be those on the south side of H dock and those on the north side of G dock.

Next will be those on the south side of G dock and those on the north side of F dock.

Next will be those on the south side of F dock and those on the north side of E dock.

Next will be those on the south side of E dock and those on the north side of D dock.

Next will be those on the south side of D dock and those on the north side of C dock.

Next will be those on the south side of C dock and those on the north side of B dock.

Next will be those on the south side of B dock and those on the north side of A dock.

We will call you at least two weeks ahead of time to let you know when you need to move your boat and to see whose

boats we have to move ourselves. We will do our best to get a waiver from any owner whose boat we have to move.

We will take pictures of how your vessel was tied up and its condition, both before and after the move.

There will be a letter going out to all tenants explaining this again (and with any additional information that is important).

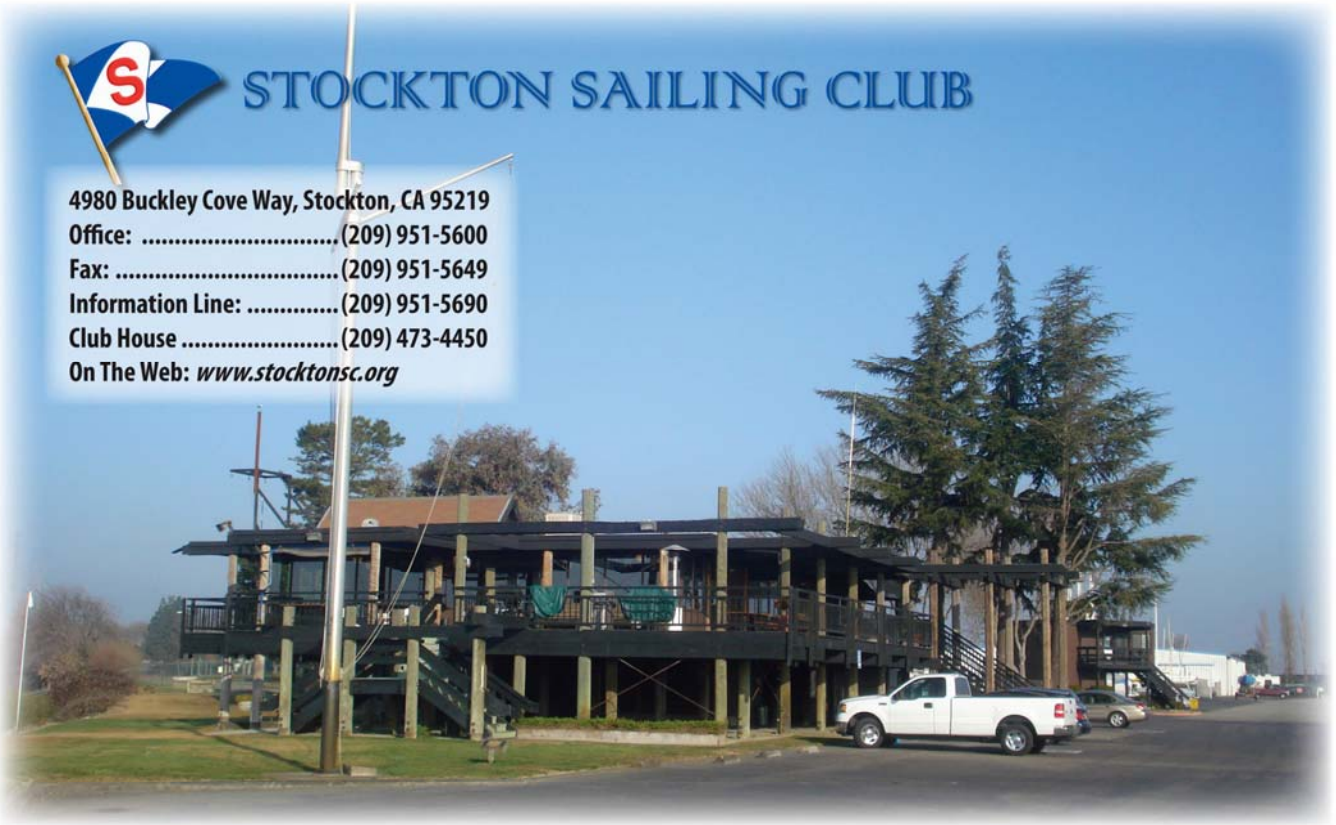
