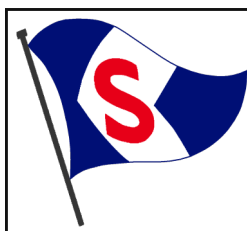

We have two bids for the work, the fire sprinkler / suppression system came in under cost expectations and one bid was close to our expectations. We now wait for the State to approve of the bid. We also need to negotiate with the state how much they will pay for the improvements and when they will pay for them. Jim has turned his duties regarding the Project over to Harbor Master, Jim Dale. Past Commodore, Richard Wright, and Treasurer, Sam Dameron, will provide assistance. Let's all give Jim Cahill a big thank you for going above and beyond to get this project this far along.

Regatta activities on the water were approved by the Board of Directors at the request of the Regatta Committee. The Committee is aware of the Coast Guard / County Regulations on events and insuring that all comply in race instructions. Wednesday Night Races have resumed so come out and enjoy. 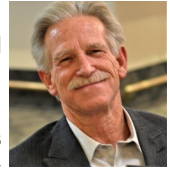

Sailing in the Time of Corona!

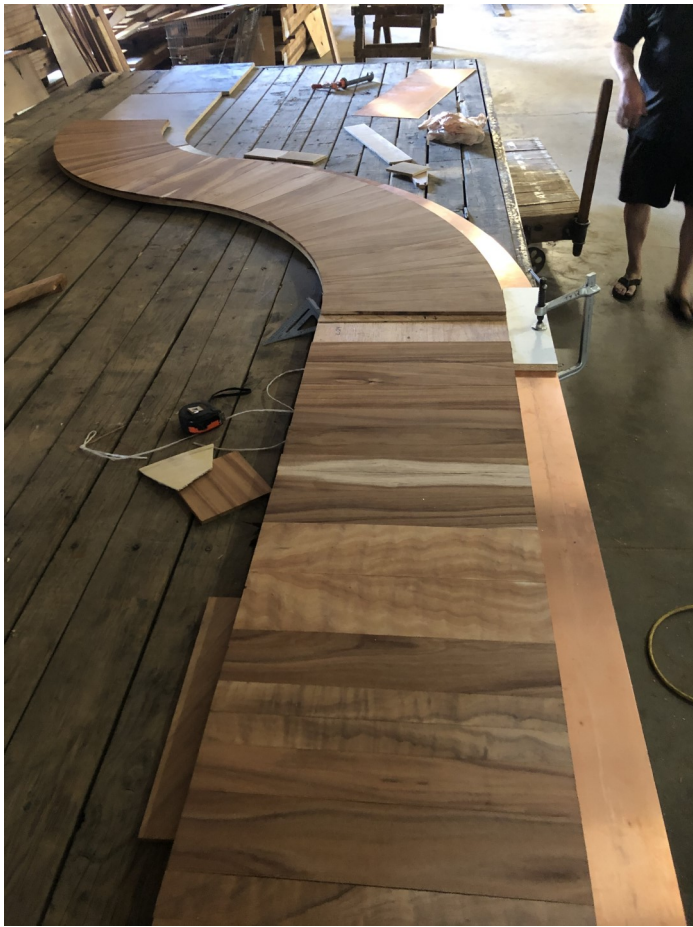
