




The Warehouse Lease Project is moving forward. The Fire suppression system is scheduled to be finished by the end of November and the main project should be completed by the end of January.



FBLI- Committee reviewed the repayment schedule for capital improvements by the State of California to the Stockton Sailing Club. The committee sought to insure adequate reserves were kept in place for the Club's operations and made its best recommendation to the Board of Directors. This was done to insure the Club's financial position is sound and safe going forward.

HARBOR AND FACILITIES- As soon as the State begins to pay rent dock renovations will be started. A new chair person will be elected for the upcoming year.

JUNIORS- Lorie Kruse and Marc Niemeyer will co-chair the junior committee for 2021. Secretary is Lorie Kruse and treasurer is Annette Smith. Juniors elected to junior board include Bella Crotty as commodore, Ashley Ragan as vice commodore and Mindy Claypool as secretary. Concerns were mentioned about the junior room that has been accessed on several occasions and left not only unlocked but equipment thrown on the floor, borrowed and not returned.

SOCIAL AND CRUISE- Linda Buck will serve as chairman in 2021. Corona virus restrictions are being followed with a 25% occupancy in the clubhouse and outside events with no more than 100 attendees. From the Galley

This month's recipe is from our great chef, Jeff Canepa. He made us some amazing food at the general meeting on October 16th. Thought we'd share his recipe for the chicken. It is an old recipe handed down by his father's Italian heritage.

ITALIAN CHICKEN

- -Start by rubbing down the chicken with olive oil.
- -Usually smaller pieces of chicken is used (like thighs)
- -Season chicken with salt & pepper and Italian seasoning mix.
- -Drain any excess olive oil so you don't stew the chicken or cook on a rack
- -Bake at 350 degrees for about 45 minutes
- -Last 10 minutes increase temperature to 450-500 degrees
- -drizzle red wine over the chicken to deglaze it and make a delicious sauce
- -cook until the alcohol smell is gone

CRANBERRY- MARSHMALLOW SALAD
