What happens now that I have submitted my membership application?

Every new member must be voted into the club by the board of directors which meet once a month on the second Tuesday of each month. You do not need to be present.

You do need to go through an orientation meeting on the Monday before the regular board meeting. It's very important that you go to the orientation as the board cannot approve your application until you do. Every applicant must go through orientation prior to the board voting. Membership Types

Full initiation fee and first month's dues must be included with application. (All Fees subject to change)

Family

Includes married couples and single individuals and their qualifying dependents Initiation Fee \$400, Approximate Monthly Dues \$85.64.

Young Adult

For families and individuals aged 21-29

Initiation Fee \$200, Approximate Monthly Dues \$42.82

Junior

For persons 8 to 21 years of age who are not dependents of family members

(Available until age 24 if full time student)

Birth date and proof of age required for young adult and junior

No Initiation Fee. Approximate Annual Dues \$52 per calendar year payable in advance

Trial Membership

The Associate Trial Membership is designed for the person that has never been a member of the Stockton Sailing Club and would like to see what the Club is all about. Associate Trial Memberships shall be available to married couples and their dependents, single persons and their qualifying dependents. Initiation fees for the Associate Trial Membership shall be at the discretion of the Board of Directors. The monthly membership dues shall be set by the Board of Directors with no additional credits given. After six (6) months the Associate Trial Membership will be automatically converted to a Family or Young Adult Membership, unless terminated by the member; all applicable dues and fees will be due at that time. The Associate Trial Membership may only be used once. All dues paid while holding this membership category are applicable to any required initiation fee. An Associate Trial Member shall have all the rights and privileges granted by the Bylaws, Rules and Policies of the Stockton Sailing Club, with the exception of holding office and/or voting. An Associate Trial Member cannot request a Leave of Absence or Cruising Status. If a Trial Member's account is not paid in full within 60 days from the date of billing the member will forfeit their Trial Membership.

No Initiation fee to start. Initiation Fee will be charged as the current rate. Less dues paid. Approximate Monthly Dues \$35. May only be used once.
