3. The platform committee may finish a fleet whenever it goes through the start/finish line. When shortening a course, the committee will display code flag "S" facing the previous rounding mark. If only certain fleets are being shortened, their insignias will be displayed along with code flag "S".
4. The distance from the Start/Finish line to "E" and back is .80 NM.
5. The distance from the Start/Finish line to "G" and back is 1.88 NM.
6. The distance from the Start/Finish line to "SC" and back is 0.2 NM
